Gospel Reading: Luke 24: 35–48

30) And it came to pass, as He sat at meat with them, He took bread, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them. 31) And their eyes were opened, and they knew Him; and He vanished out of their sight. 32) And they said one to another, "Did not our heart burn within us, while He talked with us by the way, and while He opened to us the scriptures?" 33) And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven gathered together, and them that were with them, 34) saying, "the Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon."

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread. **While they were still speaking about this, He stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you."** But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then He said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why



do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have." And as He said this, He showed them his hands and His feet.

While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, He asked them, "Have you anything here to eat?" They gave Him a piece of baked fish; He took it and ate it in front of them. He said to them, "These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled." Then He opened their minds to understand the Scriptures.

And He said to them, "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

Sacramental Policies**

Baptism

- * Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- * Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office to register for class!**
- * Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- * At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- * **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage – Couples must:

- * Contact the pastor **at least 6 months** (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- * Complete FOCCUS inventory
- * Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- * **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- * Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- * Preparation = two years of classes.
- * Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People

In this way, the ACTS Retreat fulfills the mission of: ***“Spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ among Catholic communities through ACTS.”***






