Gospel Reading: John 15: 1–8

Jesus said to his disciples: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me. **I am the vine, you are the branches.** Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in me will be thrown out like a branch and wither; people will gather them and throw them into a fire and they will be burned. - + reverential, respectful of his/her faith, and of good moral character;
- + If married, be in a valid marriage according to the law of the Catholic Church.
- + Complete Virtus Training

Altar Servers Requirements:

- + If over 18, complete Virtus training

St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

Baptism

- * Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- * Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office to register for class!**
- * Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- * At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- * **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage – Couples must:

- * Contact the pastor **at least 6 months** (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- * Complete FOCCUS inventory
- * Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- * **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- * Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- * Preparation = two years of classes.
- * Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People






