The Parish Council met on April 15, 2024

The major focus of the meeting was on the upcoming Ministries Fair set to take place after each Mass on Pentecost Weekend — May 18th/19th.

The Council also discussed the upcoming Parish Picnic on May 19th, the Fall/Halloween Festival, and a Burger Lunch proposed by the Stewardship Committee for August. This event was nicknamed Patrick's Patties.

The council has finalized the parish T-Shirt design and will make these available to order during the parish picnic.

The Diocese gave our parish 80% of our overage from the **2023** Annual Catholic Appeal. The total was \$19,069.95 and was deposited in our Building Fund.

The council also discussed security camera and light upgrades, as well as reinstating the Precious Blood at Mass on Corpus Christi.

St. Patrick Catholic Church Sacramental Policies

Baptism

- * Parents **must be registered** at St. Patrick and attend Mass for **3 months before** preparation.
- * Parents must attend Baptism Prep Class so, please **call the office to register for class!**
- * Godparents invited to attend Baptism class.
- * At least one godparent must be a Catholic good standing.
- * **Non – St. Patrick godparents** must provide a sponsorship letter from their home parish office. The letter must be received by St. Patrick Church office **prior to** requesting a date for the Baptism.

Marriage – Couples must:

- * Contact the pastor **at least 6 months** (or more) prior to desired wedding date.
- * Complete FOCCUS inventory
- * Participate in a pre-Cana course or marriage-prep weekend.
- * **NO** wedding date is guaranteed until **ALL** Diocesan and parish requirements are fulfilled.

First Communion and Confirmation

- * Family must be registered at St. Patrick.
- * Preparation = two years of classes.
- * Children must be at least **7 years old** to receive First Communion, **and** at least **14 years old** to receive Confirmation.

The Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People

is a comprehensive set of procedures established in June 2002 by the USCCB for addressing allegations of sexual abuse of minors by Catholic clergy.

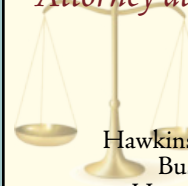

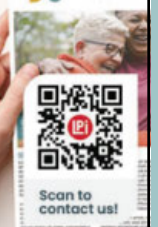
